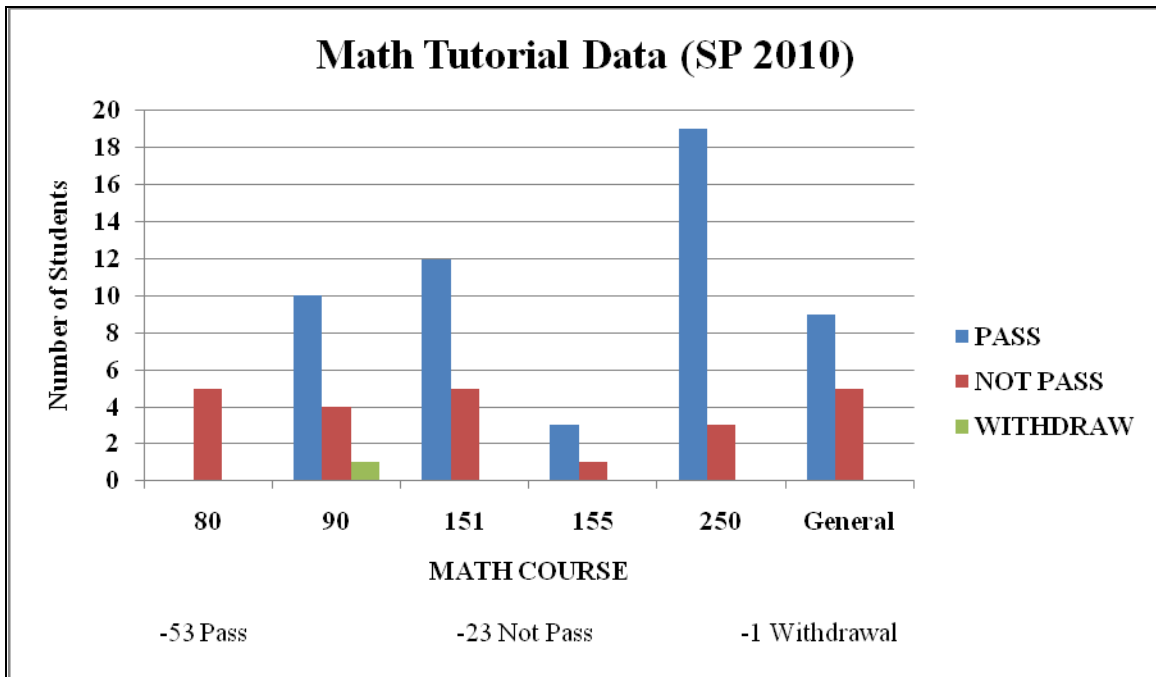
We are housed in the Student Learning Assistance Center, which is the main Center on campus for tutorials. Tutorials are open to ALL subjects.

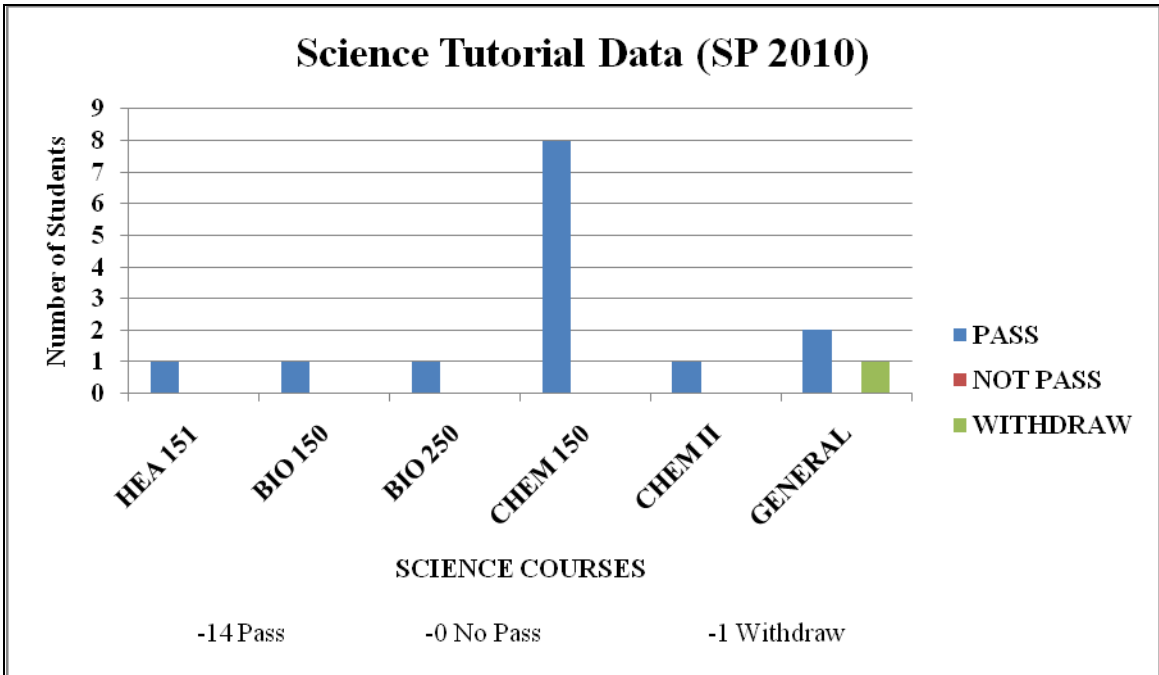
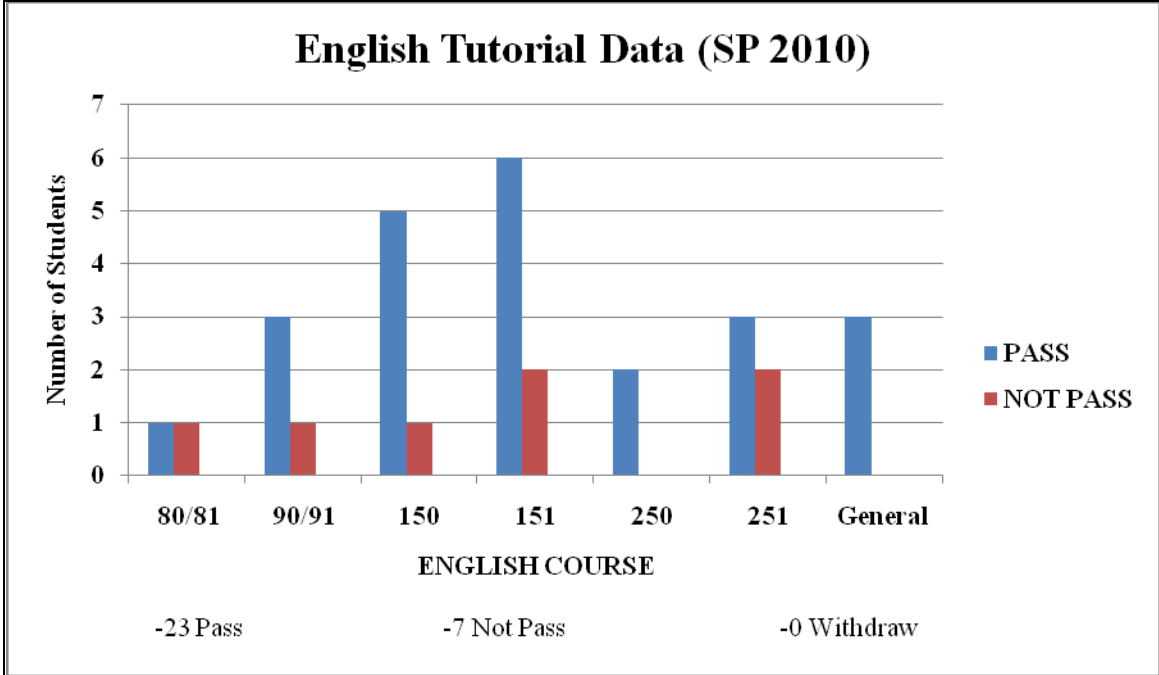
Data Collection

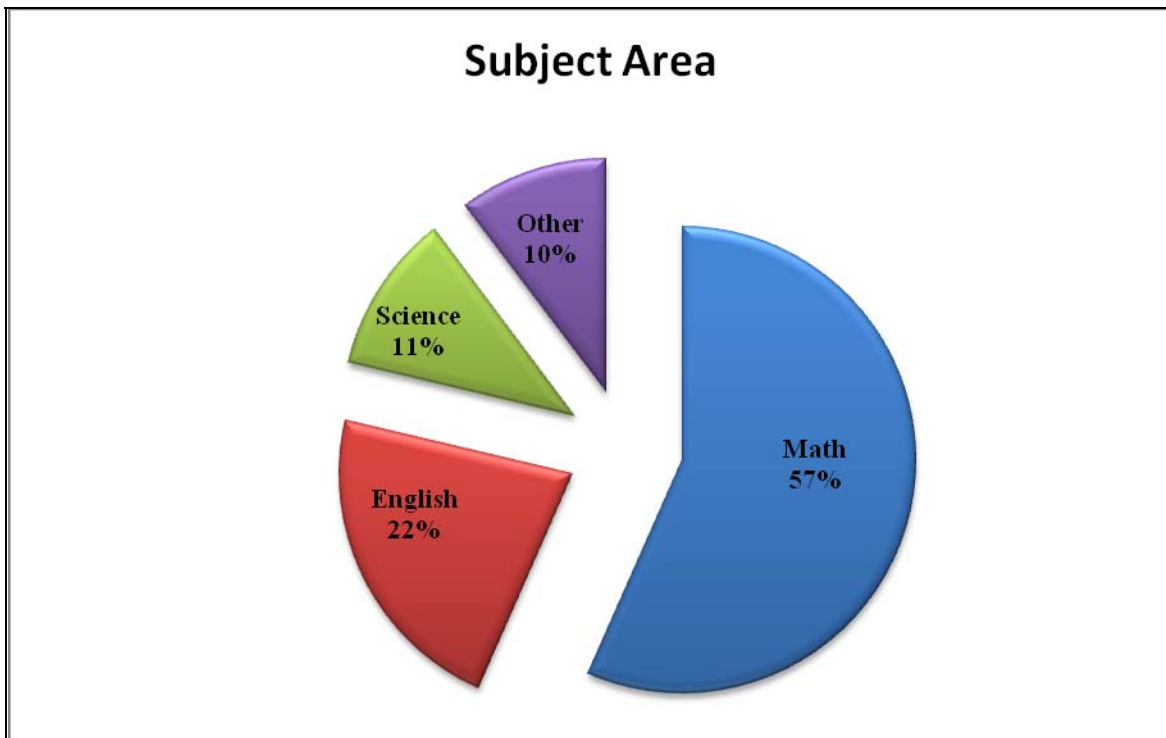
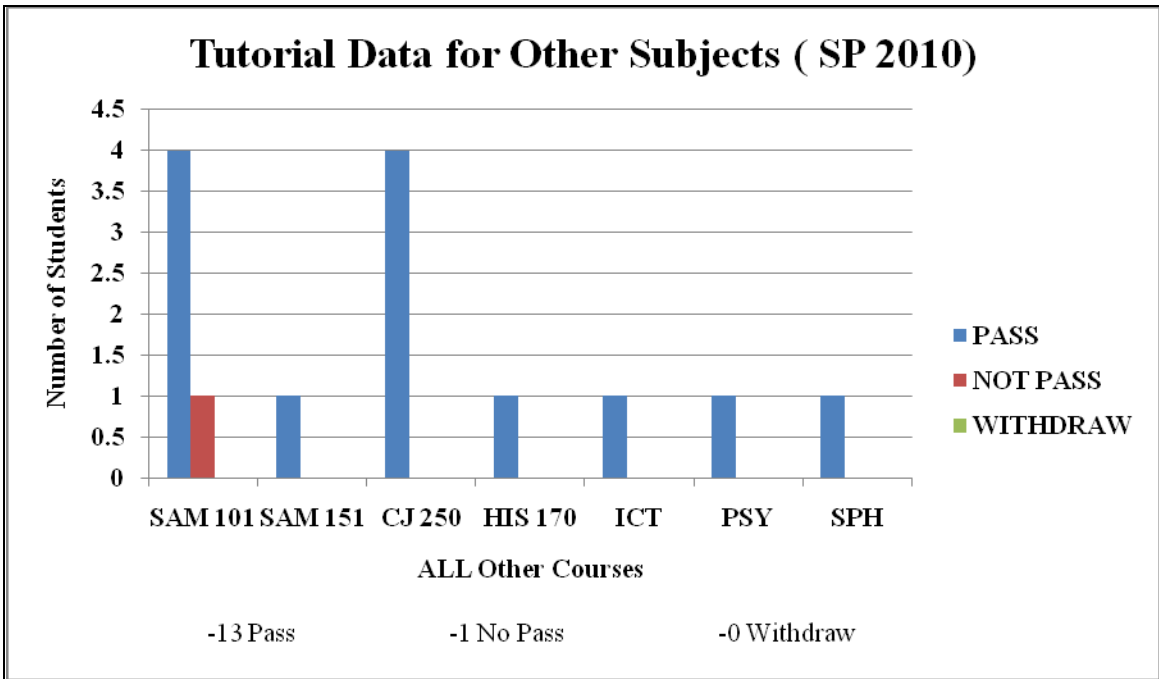
The following information is a compilation of the different courses in which assistance was provided.

- ✓ Number of Students: Pass, Not Pass, Withdraw

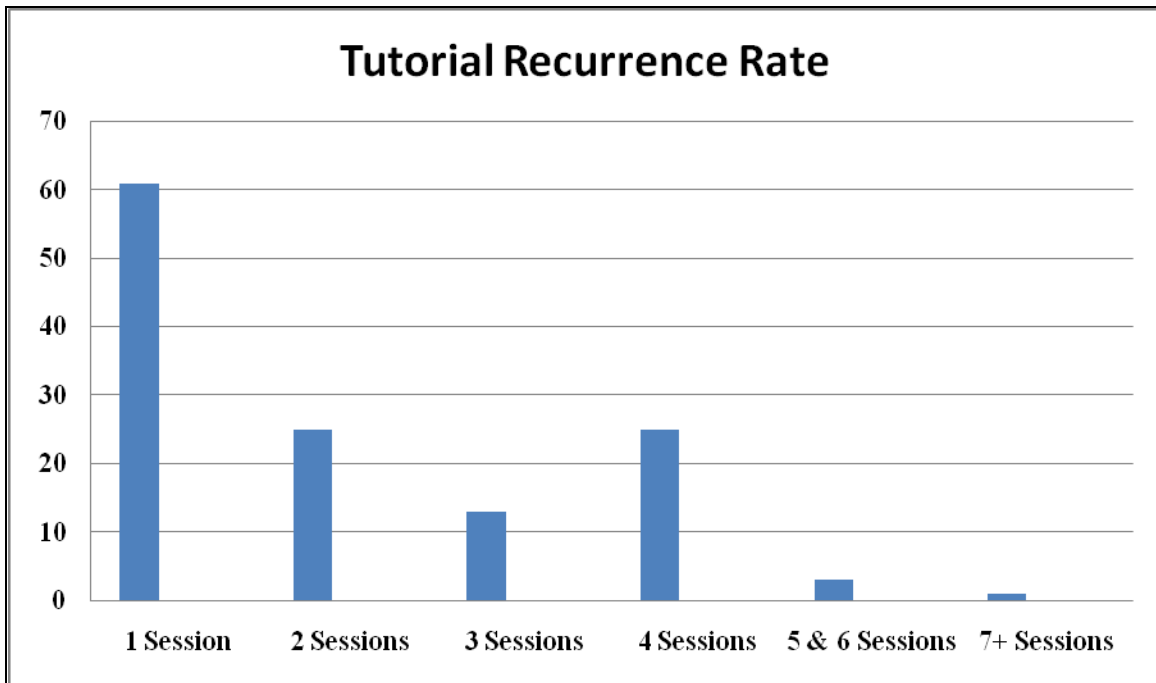






Total number of students: Math-77 English-30 Science-15 Other-14

The following graph shows the recurrence rate for each of the tutees that were tutored.



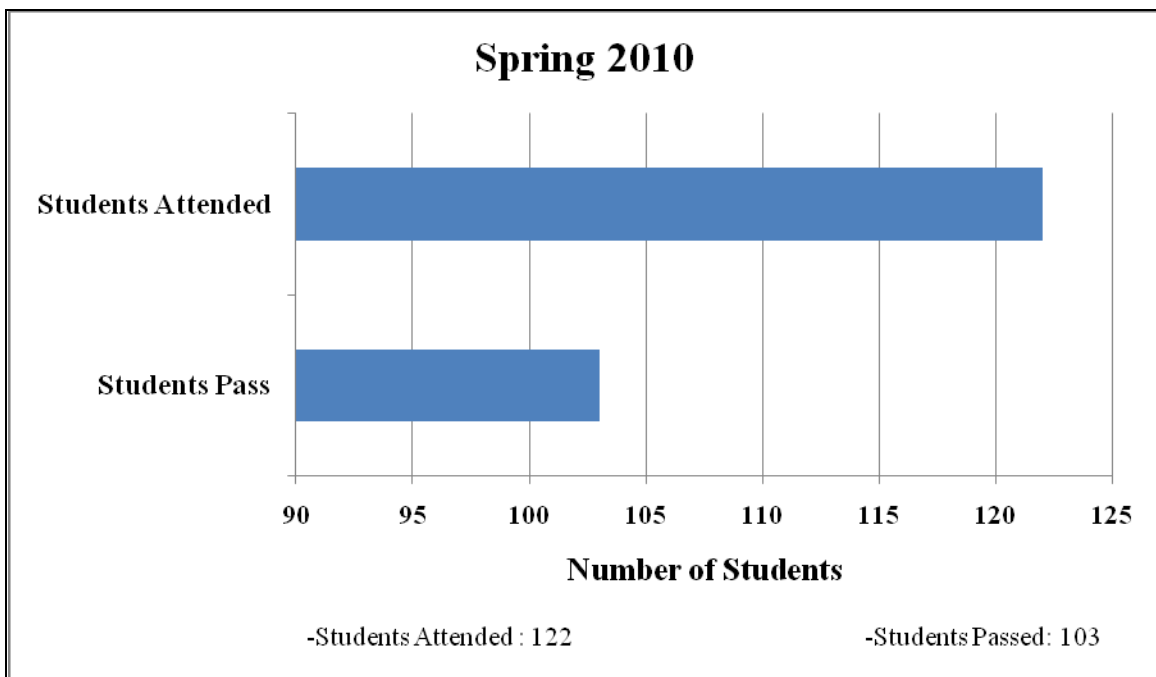

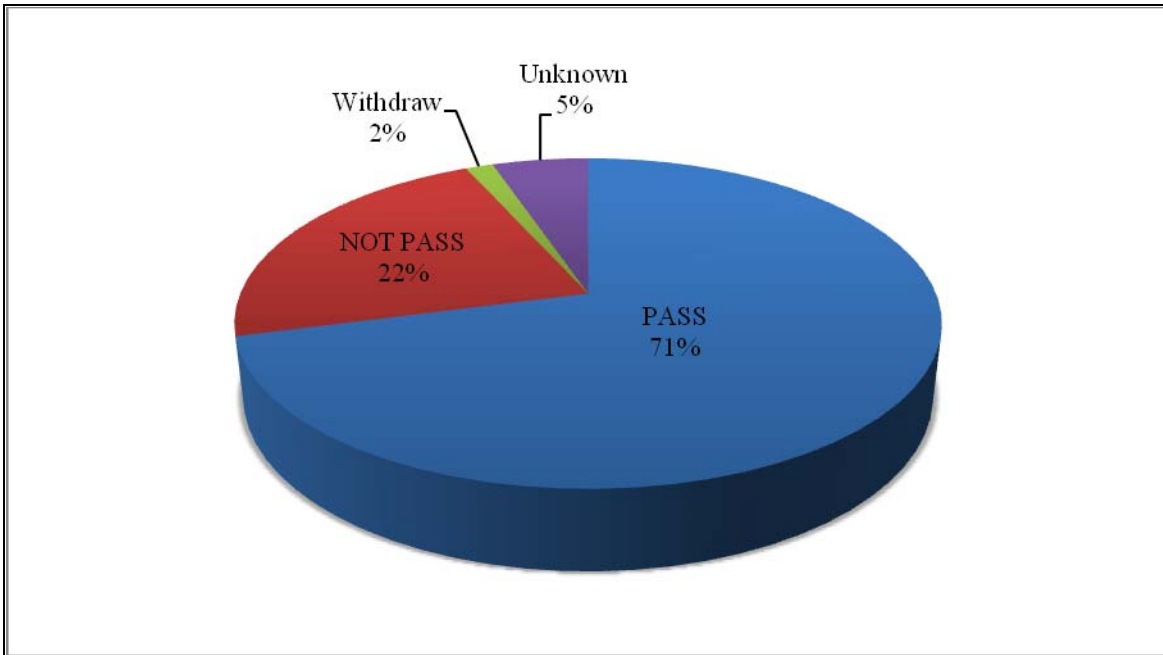
Sessions: 138
