INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Sought for summer 2011 Undergraduate Scholars

The NOAA Office of Education (OEd) is seeking NOAA offices and programs nationwide to host Undergraduate Scholarship recipients in the Educational Partnership Program (EPP) and Hollings Scholarship Program. Internship opportunities are sought for 150 scholarship recipients to participate in a 9-week OEd paid internship in NOAA mission-related research, technological, policy, management, and education activities, beginning May 31, 2011.

Starting October, 1, 2010, scholarship recipients will begin exploring the internship opportunities posted. Scholars must select an internship by April 1, 2011.

Undergraduate scholars are U.S. citizens and full-time undergraduate students majoring in NOAA mission-related disciplines, including, but not limited to, oceanic, environmental, and atmospheric sciences, mathematics, engineering, remote sensing technology, physical and social sciences including, geography, physics, hydrology, and teacher education. Scholarship recipients receive an OEd-funded award that includes academic assistance, a 10-week paid internship, housing assistance, conference travel, and round-trip travel to the internship site.

Host offices are requested to identify a discrete project that the undergraduate scholar can complete within a 9-week timeframe. Internship opportunities must be submitted in the Student Scholarship Internship Opportunity (SSIO) on-line system. To access the SSIO, go to <https://ssio.iso.noaa.gov>. The SSIO is open for past and potential NOAA mentors to view, update, delete, or create new internship opportunities.

This exciting opportunity is for students in the science and engineering fields to deepen their understanding of the role of the federal government in climate change, water quality protection, air quality improvement, remote sensing and data analysis, remediation of the natural environment, and protection of public health. Selected candidates will work in partnership with interns at the NASA Ames facility on projects that leverage EPA and NASA technologies, science, and mission priorities. A limited number of rooms in a federal dormitory-style complex may be available to summer interns at a low cost to the intern.

"The Veterans Educational Assistance Improvements Act of 2010"

Was signed into law by the President on January 4, 2011. The law makes some significant changes, primarily to the Post 9/11 (Ch 33) GI Bill but it also impacts other Education Programs. Here are some changes under Public Law (P.L.) 111-377 to VA benefits:

Provisions of the law:

- **Effective now but not payable until Oct 1, 2011:**
Expands the Post-9/11 GI Bill to include certain Active Service performed by National Guard members who served under title 32 U.S.C. for the purpose of organizing, administering, recruiting, instructing, or training the National Guard; or under section 502(f) for the purpose of responding to a national emergency.
- **Effective March 3, 2011:**
Limits active duty members pursuing a degree at more than half-time to the net cost for tuition and fees prorated based on the eligibility tiers (40% - 100%) previously established for Veterans.
Same limitations apply to transferee spouses of active duty service members.
- **Effective August 1, 2011:**
-Allows VA to pay kickers on a monthly basis instead of a lump sum at the beginning of the term.
-Also allows VA to pay kickers to those who are attending school at a half-time rate of pursuit or less.
-Allows those who are eligible for both Ch 31 Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment benefits and Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits to choose the Post-9/11 GI Bill's monthly housing allowance instead of the Chapter 31 subsistence allowance.

-Break or interval pay is no longer payable under any VA education benefit program unless under an Executive Order of the President or due to an emergency situation such as a natural disaster or strike.

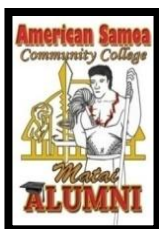
